- "The school is always very well presented, and it is evident staff take the time and care to make it an engaging environment for the children."
- "Very welcoming school."
- "Staff always visible at the start and end of the school day. Caretakers work hard to keep the site looking tidy."
- "The council could do with looking at the trees on the border of the school next to the park / football field."
- "Please close the road and ban all parking unless disabled. Could the council extend the car park of the park and stride onto the grass next to the car park/church without encroaching on the football pitches? More parking may reduce traffic down church road and therefore make it safer for those of us who park elsewhere or walk from home."
- "Whilst I have answered yes to it being a safe site this is only once you are through the gates. Outside, especially on Church Rd I do not feel it is safe at school opening and closing times. Regards signage, I feel there should be signs that dogs are not allowed."
- "I think the school is great. Nice staff the building is tidy and welcoming a few bits need fixing like the fence/decking by the classrooms which I'm sure your aware of and are on it."
- "Staff helpful and friendly, children happy."
- "Parents are communicated to regularly regarding using the park and stride, which has

varying levels of success. The changes in hours for ASC often coincide with the end of an after school club. This makes the area on church road highly congested, with many children spilling out from the gates onto the road. Frequently, parents park right next to the road, which causes an obstruction for traffic to flow freely. With the exception of the ASC, leaders cannot control parental parking (despite your best efforts) & so there is no immediate solution. There is a risk if parents are not vigilant and if someone is driving up quickly the catch the end of ASC at 4.30pm. Thank you for trying to make the area as safe as it can be!"

- "I know it is not directly your responsibility but I'm worried about safety at school pick up. There are cars double parked on either side of the road, often on the yellow lines, so you can not see clearly to cross the road, then there are loads of secondary school children on bikes, riding through at speed on the road and pavement. It feels like an accident waiting to happen. I know the caretakers try their best to help people cross but we could really do with a lollypop person to help people cross, and a traffic warden to ticket people parking ridiculously. I have seen people parked across the entrance to Burnside Gardens, on double yellow lines and on the school keep clear lines in the last week."
- "Very well run in this regard. Only query would be around use of 'designated safeguarding lead' label in the school entrance. I think 5 staff are listed as DSL's but presumably some are deputies... would be good to know as a visitor who has ultimate responsibility for SG."
- "The school itself and staff are always very welcoming and we're very happy bringing our child here."
- "Reception is welcoming. James is wonderful. Laura and Sandra open the window with a smile. School is very welcoming."
- "Staff always pleasant and easy to approach. School is always clean and tidy."
