Comments

"Extra lights on the parts of the ground between the gate near Nursery and Lighthouse would be welcome."

"I think cars drive too fast near school and it's dangerous."

"The low fencing by the office is not an adequate deterrent to people unlawfully accessing the school and children during the day. This includes the outdoor areas at the front of the school for Reception and Nursery. This needs to be addressed."

"It is confusing for new pupils/parents where certain places are, for example the halls."

"I am concerned about how parents park outside of school at the end of the school and after clubs with no regard for the safety of the children."

"Lighting needs to be improved outside Lighthouse – currently none at the back where the children play and the side is in complete darkness. This is unsafe."

"Alexandra Avenue could be made safer with more visual signs to traffic that there are children crossing and caution should be taken. A more formal crossing or 'right of way' footpath."

"My concern is around the issue of dog muck on the paths outside school."

"Wonderful that the Head and Deputy Head meet and greet on the doors in the mornings. Fab!"

"Classroom names would be great on the outside of the classroom doors as when picking up not sure which class is which."
