<p>COMMUNITY</p> 	<p>As a Church of England School, Religious Education is fundamental to developing the children's understanding of their role in a Church School and a multicultural society.</p> <p>The children understand they are part of the school <b>community</b>. They learn how to be a valued member of this <b>community</b> and their role within it. They also understand that Christianity is a global faith and they are part of the local Church as well as the wider global Christian <b>community</b>.</p>
<p>RESPECT</p> 	<p>They study key Christian values and about the other main world religions which allows them to understand and <b>respect</b> the beliefs and views of all. Pupils are taught to <b>respect</b> each other, their teachers and all members in the school and broader <b>communities</b>.</p>
<p>PERSEVERANCE</p> 	<p>Through studying the bible and other religious texts, pupils learn that <b>perseverance</b> can be important to success in life. They are encouraged to embrace challenges in their learning and life and to <b>persevere</b> despite these.</p> <p>Our RE curriculum promotes understanding, <b>respect</b> and tolerance for all religious faiths and encourages curiosity, questioning and the exploration of religious concepts.</p>
