

## What is Breakfast and Lighthouse Club like?

The clubs take place in our newly refurbished demountable, "Treasure Island". In this homely, well resourced environment, we offer warm and friendly care, alongside a varied breakfast and tea menu and fun activities.

Everyday for breakfast, we offer a choice of cereals, fruit juices and toast. For their cereal, children can choose from: Weetabix, Cheerios or Rice Krispies.

For drinks, the children can have milk, orange juice or apple juice, followed by freshly cooked toast with either butter, jam or honey. They can have as much or as little as they want.

For tea, we provide a sandwich or beans or spaghetti on toast, and a drink.

Afterwards children play together, read, watch television or do their homework. There are even copies of the children's newspaper, 'First News' available for children to read every day.

You can telephone the Lighthouse Club on 01743 233418 between 8.00am and 9.00am and from 3.00pm until 6.00pm. The phone is not monitored outside of these times.

## What times do the clubs run?

Breakfast Club is a before school club that runs from 8.00 a.m. until 8.50a.m. Lighthouse club runs from 3.00pm until 6.00pm, both from Monday to Friday.

Both clubs run in our newly refurbished demountable building, Treasure Island, drop off and collection is through the KS1 playground.

## Who looks after the children at Breakfast Club?

The children are supervised by two of our teaching assistants on a rota basis and there is always a member of the school's teaching staff in overall charge. Our staff are well qualified (all have NVQ 3 Teaching Assistant Qualifications) and our pastoral care is exceptional.

## Who can come to Breakfast or Lighthouse Club?

The clubs are open to any children who attend our school. After Breakfast Club, the children are dropped off each morning to their class by our teaching assistants and they are collected from class at 3.00pm for Lighthouse Club.

## Do the children have to come to the club everyday?

Not at all. You can use the club whenever, to fit in with your needs. Some children come to clubs every morning while other children are booked in two or three times per week. Some children just come to the clubs when their parents need to be somewhere early or cannot collect at 3.00pm on a particular day.

It's totally up to you when, and how, you would like to use the club.

## Do we need to book ahead?

For Breakfast Club it is not always necessary to book a place for your child, but for Lighthouse Club we do need you to reserve the place to ensure we know what time they will be collected. You can of course book your child in on a regular weekly basis.

## How much does it cost?

### Breakfast Club

First Child £2.50 per day  
or £10.00 per week.

Siblings - £1.50 or £6.00 per week  
You can pay on the day or pay in advance.

### Lighthouse Club

£3.50 per hour (or part hour) discounted to £10.00 for the full 3 hours - siblings £8.00

£45.00 - siblings £35.00 for the full week.
