Literacy We will be writing some persuasion texts about Shrewsbury. All nicely linked to the River Severn, we will be writing explanation texts. After half term the children will be writing Non-Chronological reports on animals and environments. Then we move on to autobiographies (Charles Darwin) and diaries linked to Easter.

Geography After going far afield in Autumn term, we will come back to Salop! The children will be learning about their county and the wonderful place in which they live—looking at physical and human geography.

<u>PHSE</u> This term we will be looking at basic first aid, mental health and how it affects us, and how feelings can be managed.


Religious Education We are looking at Judaism and then focusing on the resurrection and how it is important to Christians in the build up to Easter.
