Task: Design and make a new school award:

The 'Kindness Award'

Think about...

What is kindness?

Definition: Kindness is the quality of being friendly, generous, and considerate. Affection, gentleness, warmth, concern, and care are words that are associated with kindness. Being kind often requires courage and strength.

Think about 'kindness' and what it looks like/means/feels like.

When someone is kind to you, how do you feel?

How do you feel when you see the reaction of someone you have shown kindness to?

How can you celebrate kindness?



"Nothing beats kindness," said the horse. "It sits quietly beyond all things."

What to do:

Design and make an award/certificate/poster or picture to promote and celebrate kindness.

There are 4 different ways of entering the competition. All entries should show/represent kindness.

1. Draw/paint a picture A3/A4 in size of someone showing/feeling kindness. You can use poster paints, ink, watercolours, felt pens etc.
2. Design and make an A5 sized (half a page of paper) certificate to celebrate kindness. It can be drawn, painted, coloured with glitter pens, felt pens etc. or even made on the computer. You must have space for the name of the person getting the award and the date.
3. Design and make a poster, A3/A4 in size, to encourage everyone to be kind in school. It can be highly decorated with glitter, paint, collage etc. The winning posters will be framed and displayed in school. So, think about an eye-catching message and picture/design.
4. Design and make an award to celebrate kindness. E.g., a cup, a trophy, a medal, a plaque, a rosette, a badge, a ribbon etc in 3D form. You can use junk modelling, nets, objects, fabric, ribbon etc to create the award.

Class Teachers will then choose 4 winning designs from each class (1 from each category) and these will be put forward to the semi-final.

From these designs a winner from each category will be selected.

THE PRIZE!

The overall winning designs for each category (picture/poster/certificate/award) will be used to decorate the school and one of them will be made into a 'real award'. This will then be presented in school, at the end of every half term.

Plus, there will be a special prize for the overall winners in each category and runner-up goodies will be awarded.
