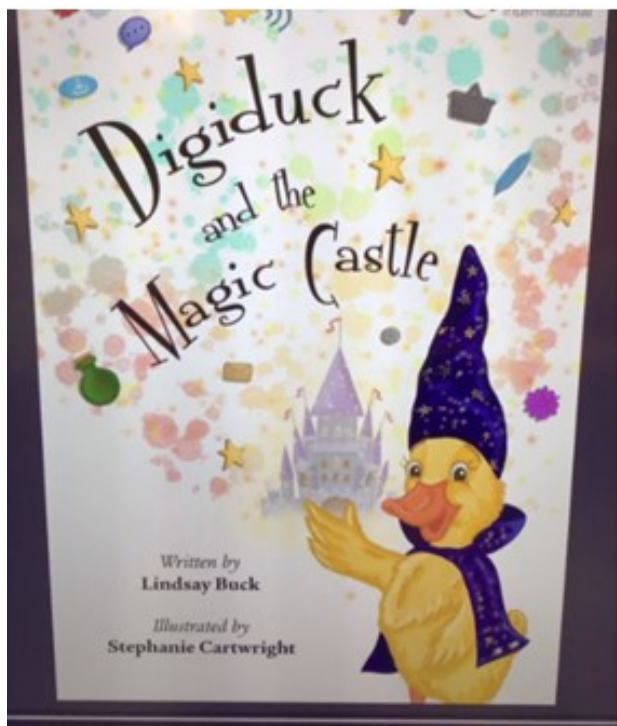
Smartie the Penguin brought us a story to share to help us learn all about how to stay safe if we play games online.
