

## Literacy

We will be writing narrative stories, explanation texts, recounts and diary entries linked to our theme. We will be creating instructions on how to make Tudor biscuits. Children will develop their sentence writing skills using different sentence structures. We will also be reading the novels 'Spymaster' and 'Diver's Daughter'.

## Maths

This term we will be exploring fractions in their different forms and division. We will also be learning about decimals and shape. We will be working very hard on our times tables, while we build towards the test in June. We will also be starting to work on measures and angles.

## Science

Our Science units this term will be "Animals including humans". We will be learning about how the digestive system works, the functions of teeth and the different food chains in our world. We will be completing different investigations and developing our understanding of prediction, results and conclusions.

## Art / Design and Technology

This term, we will be focussing on Still Life and taking inspiration from Paul Cezanne. We will be creating our own pieces of art using layers. We will be making Tudor biscuits for our DT this term to link with our topic.

## Physical Education

This term we will be creating and performing our own dance routines linked to the Tudors. We will be taking part in gymnastics and athletics this term. There will also be opportunities for children to take part in sport outside of school.

## Computing/ Music

This term we are looking forward to learning more about being safe when using a computer online. We will also be developing our skills further in computer science through the "logo" program. In music, we are learning about composing our own lyrics and rhythm and learning about brass instruments.

Focussing on Henry the VIII and his six wives and Elizabeth I. In geography, we are studying our local area.
