<u>Literacy</u> This term our writing will be focusing on narratives and how we can include detailed descriptions within this. We will also be covering explanations and writing newspaper reports linked to the second world war.

<u>D&T</u> Over the next two terms, we will be looking at textiles and mechanisms. The children will design and produce their very own cushion and they will learn how to use electrical control to move a vehicle.

Geography As geographers, we will be looking at the physical and human geographies in our local area and regional area.

PHSE We will be focusing on different relationships, changing and growing, adulthood, independence and moving to secondary school transition will play a vital part in our Summer Term.

Religious Education we will be focusing on the questions—What kind of King is. Jesus and How we make sense of hardship and suffering?

Maths We will be covering the topics of: ratio, scale factors, data handling including pie charts and their construction. Followed by, coordinates, time and time problems, line graphs and multistep problems.

Art In this pathway, children explore both traditional and contemporary artists and craftspeople using intricate cut-outs to create artwork which is meaningful to the pupils from other artists and craftspeople, and adapt ideas to suit their own way of working. Pupils create puppets working in collaboration.

Year Six-Summer Term



Science As scientists, we will be looking light — how we see it, what it consists of, refraction and reflection.

After half term, we will be focusing on electricity and circuits, which we will be having electricians coming in to talk to us about how it all works.

Computing In the computer suite, we will be focusing on computer science - furthering our coding skills and designing our own games.

French— We will be learning how to tell the time as well as recapping days of the week and months. The children will be reading, writing and conversing in French.

Music We will be listening to, discussing and interpreting a range of music, including Mozart and Schubert.

<u>PE</u> is on a Wednesday afternoon. We shall focus on athletics, rounders and cricket for this term. In the second half term, we will also be swimming as part of our PE sessions.
