

Literacy

We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction books about Penguins and Polar Bears. We will be writing stories, information texts and poetry linked to our theme. Children will continue to write different kinds of sentences including questions and exclamations.

Maths

This term the children will be naming and describing 2D and 3d shapes and recapping multiplication. They will be concentrating on the 2, 3, 5, and 10 times tables. The children will be learning a variety of methods to add and subtract two 2 digit numbers. Furthermore, the children will be learning to tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes.

Science

Our Science unit this term will be Animals, Including Humans. We will learn about how humans and other animals need good hygiene and a balanced diet to grow into healthy adults. We will carry out a range of investigations based on exercise and health, collecting and presenting data using graphs and charts.

Design and Technology

In Design and Technology we will develop skills to prepare fruit and vegetables, including shopping, peeling and slicing. We will then use these skills to design, make and evaluate a healthy pizza.

Religious Education

This half term we will be finding out more about the Islamic faith. We will find out about the Qur'an and how to treat it with respect. We will listen to more stories of the prophet Muhammed and reflect upon why these are important to Muslims.

Computing

This half term we will focus on the Digital Literacy element of the computing curriculum. We will learn about how to keep safe when using computers at home and at school. We will find out how digital literacy is used at home and in the workplace.

Year 2 theme - Penguins and Polar Bears

History

In History, we will be learning about the life of Captain Scott and we will be tracking his exploration on timelines. We will answer questions linked to timelines and compare photos and pictures from the past.

Geography

In Geography, we are learning about Hot and Cold places. We will be identifying both the North and South Poles and exploring what impact the Equator has on climate.

Physical Education

This half term we will be focusing on how to move our bodies with control and appropriate tension in gymnastics. We will explore a range of movements and jumps with pointed toes.

In multi skills we will learn to balance on low equipment, changing direction quickly with balance and control. We will complete challenges as a team.
